Best Hikes in Escalante: Calf Creek Falls, Lower; Calf Creek Falls is one of the most enchanting areas of the Grand Staircase-Escalante area, a verdant oasis amid tumbled stone monoliths. Devils Garden; The Devils Garden is located in the Grand Staircase-Escalante area, on the Hole-in-the-Rock Road, 12 miles south of Highway 12 and the town of Escalante.

This hike begins at the Escalante River trailhead, just off Scenic Byway 12 and slightly north of the Boynton Overlook. There are multiple river crossings on this hike, so be sure you are prepared to get your feet wet (and then sandy)!

The Escalante Canyons section is the most popular area of the monument, especially among hikers. Active waterfalls, arches, riparian oases, sculpted slickrock and narrow canyons are part of the appeal of hikes through the Escalante ' s backcountry. The Grand Staircase area is more remote and less visited.

The trail to Lower Calf Creek Falls is one of the more accessible hikes in Escalante, as the trailhead is directly on the main highway. This 6 mile round-trip trail travels through a broad but beautiful canyon, leading to a soaring 126-foot waterfall. A majority of the trail is flat and easy, making it a great hike for beginners.

GSENM Hiking: Skutumpah Terrace From the east side of Zion National Park, enter the Grand Staircase-Escalante National Monument from Glendale, Utah. Follow the Bench Road to the junction with Skutumpah Road and the GSENM kiosk. Continue on Skutumpah Road to the next GSENM kiosk.
