Clinical trials are research studies performed in people that are aimed at evaluating a medical, surgical, or behavioral intervention. They are the primary way that researchers find out if a new treatment, like a new drug or diet or medical device (for example, a pacemaker) is safe and effective in people.

Clinical trials are an essential part of cancer research and care, with around 1 in 6 people with cancer taking part in research to access new methods of care and help improve the care received by future patients. But like cancer services, such as screening and diagnosis, the COVID-19 pandemic has heavily disrupted cancer research. Because clinical trials are often based in hospitals, the risk of COVID-19 infection forced many researchers to pause recruitment in order to keep patients safe.

As of October 2020, there were 321 candidates for vaccines intended to provide acquired immunity against coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19), a 2.5 fold increase since April. Medical research studies involving people are called clinical trials. There are two main types of trials or studies - interventional and observational. Interventional trials aim to find out more about a particular intervention, or treatment. People taking part are put into different treatment groups, so that the research team can compare the results.
