Physical milestones This year, children may not only grow by leaps and bounds, but also learn to leap and bound! Expect to see big things happening with the big muscles (gross motor skills), as well as development in small muscle movement (fine motor skills). Most 2-year-olds learn to do things like these by their third birthday:

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
